GUIDELINES TO THE FACULTIES
1. A separate activity calendar will be issued by all departments comprising their departmental technical, cultural, sports, co- curricular and extra-curricular activities / events planned for Even Semester 2025-26.
2. Prepare date-wise lecture plan, submit it to the respective Head of the Department latest by 30.01.2026. Attach a copy of the lecture plan to the course file of the subject.
3. Additional doubt clearing classes may be arranged for slow learners or for students who have missed the classes due to unavoidable circumstances.
4. No class should be left unattended as per the time table but if inevitable then proper intimation in this regard to HOD is must.
5. The attendance of classes must be uploaded on college ERP on daily basis.
6. Answer Copies of Sessional Test /PUT should be evaluated and shown to the students within four days and ensure the uploading of marks on Institute ERP.
7. All are required to take proper prior permission from respective HOD before availing any type of leave. Avoid pre-fix OR suffix type of leaves.
8. Invigilation duty has to be performed as per the schedule by exam cell. In case of any absence, a substitute must be provided by the concerned faculty/Department.

GUIDELINES TO THE STUDENTS
1. RAGGING is a punishable offence; all are required to refrain from it. FIR shall be lodged against culprit, as per orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court.
2. Sessional tests 1 will be of 1:30 hrs duration and PUT will be of 3 hrs duration (1st ST from Unit 1 & 2 and PUT from the whole syllabus).
3. All students are required to maintain minimum 75% of attendance (in each theory and practical subjects) before appearing in sessional tests / PUT.
4. List of students having shortage of attendance will be displayed/informed to the students by the department before the commencement of sessional tests/exams.
5. Minimum 75% overall attendance is required to appear in the University End Semester examination as per university guidelines.
6. The students are advised to continuously access their college ERP/AKTU ERP account. The records of attendance and performance will be uploaded there.
7. Students are advised to submit their fees on time as per the circular from the CED Office.
8. Any student found engaged in malpractices during exam will be debarred from the exams.
